Registration Requirements for Veterinary License in the N.W.T.

1. Completed Application Form.
2. Certified true copy of degree in veterinary medicine (translated if not in English). If certified true copy cannot be provided, original transcripts must be sent from the school of veterinary medicine directly to the Registrar's Office.
3. Copy of Certificate of Qualification (CQ) issued by the National Examining Board of the Canadian Veterinary Medical Association.
4. Proof of current licensure in a province of Canada.
5. Certificate of Standing from all jurisdictions currently AND previously licensed to be sent directly to Registrar from the licensing authority.
6. Up to date and detailed curriculum vitae/resume.
7. Three (3) current letters of reference from individuals who can speak of applicant's work. These are to be sent directly to the Registrar from the Referee.
8. Photocopy of birth certificate or citizenship documentation (if Canadian Citizen) or valid immigration or work permit (if not a Canadian Citizen).
9. Cheque, money-order, or Visa authorization, payable to Government of the N.W.T. for:
Annual Fee: \$200.00

Note: Licensing year is January 16 to January 15th of the following year.
